

Miss Fulton County & Miss Montgomery County Scholarship Organization

2020 Bright Stars Application

The Bright Stars is a non-competitive, mentorship program for girls and boys that allows them to perform onstage during the 2020 Miss Fulton County & Miss Montgomery County Competition. The other benefits include the following:

- Their photo in the official Miss Fulton County & Miss Montgomery County Competition Program Book
- Their name will be announced from the stage during the competition by the emcees.
- A pizza party with Miss Fulton County, Isabelle Henderson, and Miss Montgomery County, Lexi Swatt.
- Complimentary admission to the competition. (This ticket covers the Bright Star only. Family and friends must purchase their own tickets.)
- Reserved seating during the competition. (This seating is for the Bright Star only.)

Eligibility

To participate in the Bright Stars program, you must agree to these terms and meet these requirements:

1. The child must be at least 5 years of age as of December 1, 2019, and must not turn 13 before May 28, 2020.
2. The child must live or attend school in Fulton or Montgomery County.
3. You must pay a \$25 application fee by check or money order payable to The Miss Fulton County Scholarship Program, which is due at the same time as this completed application.
4. You must submit a photo of your child to be used in our promotional material. Headshots are preferred but they do not need to be professional photos (and if they are professional photos, please include the photographer's written permission that the photo may be reproduced for this purpose.
5. The application Due Date is December 15, 2019. The application and payment must be signed but may be submitted via email to missfultoncountyny@gmail.com no later than the Due Date. The fee must be mailed to Miss Fulton County and Miss Montgomery County Scholarship Organization, % Jennifer Wojeski, PO Box 622, Gloversville, NY, and must be postmarked no later than the Due Date. The photo must be sent to missfultoncountyny@gmail.com no later than the Due Date.
6. The child must be able to attend the mandatory rehearsal on Friday, January 17, 2020, from 5:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. and the show Sunday, January 19, 2020, from 3:00 p.m. until it ends. Both the rehearsal and the show will be held at the Gloversville Middle School.
7. Your child should wear "fancy dress" attire for the competition. We ask that girls wear knee or tea-length dresses, jumpsuits, or pants and a blouse. Boys should wear dress pants or chinos with a collared shirt. Ties and jackets are optional.
8. You may submit Salute Pages for your Bright Star, which will be included in the program book. The Salute Page Form is a separate form that can be downloaded from our website or emailed upon request. Completed forms and payment in full are due (in hand) no later than December 31, 2019.
